

SUMMER CLUB

Our summer club at Park House school was created to continue the engagement of our young people, catch up in education, sustain effective teacher pupil relationships and develop their social and emotional skills through therapeutic and holistic means.

Providing them with this space allowed us to `check in` with our young people, offer catch up opportunities during the summer holidays.

The summer club ran for two days and was attended by 10 of our young people (from a roll of 15). Our sessions provided opportunities for our young people to complete academic activities in all areas of their curriculum, work as a team, problem solve and think and explore creatively.

Activities which could be accessed included but were not exclusive to; Lego activities, horticulture, additional subject support in, Maths, English, reading, ARTS MARK, working with a professional spray painter, creating a mural for the schools garden space, tie dying, painting, pottery, wellbeing skills, social skills with group working, transitional activities for young people who have not been at the school before, bike skills, sports and games, cookery and independence skills.
