

School School Games Mark GOLD!

The School Games Mark is a government-led award scheme. It celebrates schools' commitment to developing competitive sport within their school and community. Park House has recently been awarded a GOLD award in recognition of all the hard work that staff and students put in to increasing sport and activity in the school

Park House school is the absolute definition of providing all inclusive physical activity opportunities for young people. Their provision may look "different" to that of a main stream school, but each and every young person in their care receives individualised opportunities through physical activity and sport. The school are engaged with the School Games provision and also our inclusive provision so they make the most of all external opportunities available to them, therefore increasing every child's opportunity to achieve 60 active minutes. The school thrives on physical activity and it is often used as an intervention aid to support the individual needs of each child. Each child will have their provision shaped around their needs and their wants, inclusion doesn't get any better than this! The school also work with local clubs and providers to ensure that there are pathways available to their pupils should they wish to try physical activity in the community. The school has mostly male pupils, but the female pupils have equal access and opportunity to physical activity and sport.

Leadership and youth voice are wholly valued in the school and most activities are co-designed and co-created along with the pupils. This in turn helps to provide positive experiences for pupils and the formation of a positive relationship with physical activity and sport (physical literacy). Congratulations again Park House School, I look forward to working with you all again next year.

Congratulations to Kane and Ben who have completed and passed their silver award!






Black Rock Adventure Day


